Tender schedule will be issued only to the contractors with satisfactory record of work.

1. The intending tenderer's are required to submit the EMD amount at the time of purchase of tender schedule.
2. Contractors approaching for tender schedules have to produce a certificate from any of the areas where they are doing works since last three years or they have to produce a renewal certificate from CGM (CIVIL) otherwise schedules will not be issued to them.
3. (a) Applications for issue of tender documents will be received upto 4.30 PM on **02-08-2010** at the office of S.E.(CIVIL)/MNG.
(b) Tender schedules will be sold to the contractor or through his authorized representative from the date of publication of tender notice. Tender schedule will not be supplied by post. Tender schedules should be collected in person (contractor/his authorized representative) after payment of tender cost in cash only. Tender schedules will be sold upto 4.30 PM on **03-08-2010** at the office of S.E (CIVIL)/MNG.
- 4.(a) The tenderer's are allowed to submit the duly filled in tenders personally or through his authorized representative only and not by post during the working hours on any working day from the date of publication of tender notice upto the time and date as indicated below (b) The tenders will be received upto 3.00 PM on **06-08-2010** and will be opened at 4.00 PM. on the same day at the office of SO to GM/MNG.
5. All contractors who purchase tender schedules will get back their EMD within 15 days from opening of tender.
6. If the contractor fails to tender for the above work within the time his EMD will be forfeited.
7. Earnest Money Deposit can be paid in the form, Demand Draft, FDR. In case of deposit EMD can be paid in the form of FDR duly endorsed in favour of SCCL. If the EMD is to be paid in the form of DD it should be payable at Manuguru Branch of any of the Nationalized Banks.

8. FDRs/DDs so submitted should be valid for a minimum period of four months from the date of opening of the tender indicated in Para No.4(b) above. The same shall be extended by the successful tenderer for duration of contract till EMD is refunded.
9. The tenderer has to keep his tender valid for four months from the date of opening of the tender
10. Request for adjustment of pending bills towards EMD or resubmission of once discharged FDR taken on other works will not be entertained.
11. The EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderer on application at the expiry of the period of validity of tender or the entrustment of work to the successful tenderer whichever is earlier.
12. Tender should be submitted only in tender schedule purchased by the tenderer from the Company. Offers which are not submitted in the tender schedule form sold by the Company will be summarily rejected.
13. The cost of tender schedule will not be refunded to the buyer under any circumstances.
14. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
15. The undersigned reserves the right to accept, any tender in full or in part or to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons.
16. The contractor/tenderer should invariably quote it's CST/GST/Registration number under the Sales Tax Act. Otherwise Company has right to reject the application/tender summarily.
17. The contractor/Bidder should have an independent PF code No. allotted by Asst Regional PF Commissioner.
18. It is mandatory for the contractor to cover contract labour under provision of CMPF scheme or EPF scheme as the case may be and its proper implementation.
