All the vehicles should incorporate the required features, as specified vide DGMS (Tech) Circular No. 06 of 2020, Dt.27.02.2020

The important features for LMVs are as follows:

- a) Seat belt and seat belt reminder
- b) Auto dipping system for head lights

* The vehicle should be in the name of successful contractor

Note: The above mentioned quantity is tentative and may increase or decrease and area of deployment may also change.

3) Model of the Vehicle: First Time Registered after opening of the tender, the vehicle should be in the name of the successful contractor only.

4) Eligibility criteria.

Preference for awarding the contract will be given in the following order.

- a) **1st Category** :Project Affected Persons means project displaced persons and Land oustees come under 1st category and they will be treated equally.

To allow sons of PDFs/ PAFs to file tenders for hired vehicles under 1st Category (however all Categories are equal at Corporate), one vehicle at a time per family in SCCL, in consideration of letter issued byGM/Estates vide ref.No.CRP/ES/P/37/Corp/61; Dated:18.01.2020, subject to providing the following documents:

- a) A Family Member Certificate from the Tahsildar is required to be submitted only in case of decease Project Displaced Person / Project Affected person to allow sons of PDFs/PAFs to file tenders for hired vehicles.
- b) An undertaking from the applicant confirming that at present there is no vehicle allotted to his family members in SCCL.
- c) Consent from all remaining family members

Note: If 1st category persons are not available then 2nd category persons will be given opportunity.

- b) **2nd Category:** Dependents of Ex-Employees of SCCL who are not provided job or Ex-Employees of SCCL come under 2nd category.

SCCL Identity card / Hospital Book SCCL Pay slip with Employee code No.

After submitting any of the above, they should get Certificate that he is dependent of Ex-employee of SCCL or Ex-employee of SCCL from that Area and submit the same to In-charge, personnel Dept., YLD Area. Further, the In-charge Personnel Department, YLD Area will forward the same to be enclosed to the application after due certification.

Note: If 2nd category persons are not available then 3rd category persons will be given opportunity.

- c) **3rd Category:** Others come under 3rd category

Persons falling under category 1 & 2 are permitted to deploy one vehicle per head only. Further, it is to inform that first preference will be given to YLD Area persons only. If no response is received within the Area, then the offers of the other Areas will be considered in the same order of eligibility criteria.

Project displaced persons and land oustees, ex-employees/dependents of ex-employees who have been allotted/already selected for deployment of vehicle at any Area of SCCL under unit rate system are not eligible for this Enquiry and the same is to be confirmed by the Applicants.

After completion of the tender process and placement of order, if it is found that the person is already allotted / selected for deployment of vehicle at any other Area of SCCL, the vehicle will be withdrawn immediately and EMD and Security Deposit and pending bills, if any, will be Forfeited.

- 5) If the Tenderer is a Project affected person / Project displaced person, his tender should accompany the following letter duly signed by the Tenderer with the following details.
- a. Extent of land acquired
 - b. Survey No.
 - c. Village.
 - d. Mandal.
 - e. Award No & date .
 - f. Purpose for which it was acquired.
 - g. Certificate from the Govt. Authorities about his identity.
 - h. PAN Card acknowledgement of application for PAN Card along with the Bid

Therefore, the eligibility of Tenderer under the above Category is subject to verification of the genuineness of the details submitted by the Tenderer

- 6) In case of Dependents of Ex-employees of SCCL, who were not provided job or Ex-employees of SCCL, they should submit any of the following document to the respective Personnel Department of Yellandu Area.

Without the above documents, the applications received cannot be considered for preference category.

- 7) In case the tenderer is Driver-cum-owner, he is required to submit the relevant Documents (valid driving license etc.)
- 8) Draw will be conducted for number of Bidders equal to the number of Vehicles. Bidders will be Selected. Additionally, a number of Bidders equal to twice the number of vehicles will also be selected in the lottery and will be kept as standby.
- 9) All the above Bidders which are selected in the lottery along with standby Bidders selected in lottery will be given lottery serial number and sent for technical evaluation.
- 10) On confirming the Technically and Commercially acceptability of the Bidders which are standing in lottery serial will be considered for the award of contract. Bidders in the standby list will be considered for award of contract as per serial number in the lottery list on confirming their technically and commercially acceptability if any dropouts before their serial number. The standby list will be maintained for a period of 2(Two) years from the date of opening of concerned enquiry for future requirements of vehicles, if any.

11) EMD & Security Deposit:

For 3 Ton PF Truck & 2WD Non-AC Camper Jeeps & 2WD Non-AC Multy Utility Vehicles:

- a) EMD of Rs.7500/-(Rupees seven thousand five hundred only) for 2WD AC Jeeps, Non-AC Jeeps, 2WD Non-AC Camper and for 3 Ton Platform Truck EMD of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten thousand only) per vehicle shall be submitted along with Tender and the successful tenderer shall deposit sum of Rs.5,000/- per each vehicle as security deposit by way of DD with in two weeks from the date of commencement of work. Persons falling under 1st & 2nd category are exempted from submission of EMD.

- 12) **PROCESSING FEE (Non Refundable):** An amount of Rs.590/- (Rupees Five Hundred and Ninety Only) Rs.500/- +Rs.90/- GST per tender schedule is to be paid by cash only, at the office of the General Manager, Yellandu. On submission of paid receipt, Tender Schedule can be obtained from the Office of SE(E&M), Purchase Department at General Manager Office, (PO) Yellandu, Bhadradi Kothagudem District-507124 from **13.06.2026** on any working day between 10:00AM to 04:30PM.

- a) **Last date for issue of Tender Schedules** : **04.07.2026 upto 4:30 PM.**
- b) **Last date for Receipt of Tender Documents** : **05.07.2026 upto 12:00 Noon.**
- c) **Date of opening of Tender Documents** : **05.07.2026 at 03:30 PM.**
- d) **Date of Draw (Lottery)** : **Will be intimated later.**

The tenderer shall enclose all the required documents at the time of submission only. **The tenders without proper documents will be rejected.**
