Applications are invited from interested vehicle owners for deployment of following vehicle in SCCL, Manuguru situated in Bhadradi Kothagudem District of Telangana State for a period of 5 years under Unit rate system with following terms & conditions.

Corrigendum was already published for change in number of ambulances from 2 Nos. to 3 Nos. Present corrigendum is published for extending the date issue of Tender documents.

(ii) Requirements (compulsory)

- The Ambulance should be of standard design and should have minimum two stretcher holders cum flat seats both sides with suitable thickness and flat foam cushion seats to avoid discomfort to the patient, one scoop stretcher , two attendants seats in patients cabin, one Doctors seat in Drivers Cabin, stand for 2 saline bottles, Hangers for I.V. Fluids preferably with bottle immobilizer, First Aid Box, Drug Cabinet, Water Tank and Wash Basin etc.
- Monococque type body (108 type model)
- Provision of sliding windows should be provided in case of AC System failure
- AC vent should be Roof mounted
- Vinyl Flooring which should be easily washable and for the purpose of disinfecting the Ambulance after shifting of the patient.
- Seat Belts / Restraints both for patients and the attendant seat should be provided. One foldable wheel chair should be provided in the Ambulance.
- Stretcher- 1 No.
- Two fans to be provided in the cabin.
- Multiple handle bars to be fixed.
- Multiple CFL Light points to be provided.
- Wall clock to be fixed in the cabin.
- Provision for Mobile charger to be fixed.
- Two way communication with cabin / driver.
- O2 cylinder to fix with sufficient clamps to avoid movement and sound during running.
- Space for all medical equipment i.e. Ventilator, Multipara Monitor, Defibrillator, Infusion pump, Suction apparatus and Monitors etc.,
- Aluminum / Hindalium pull out stretchers

- Extra battery / large capacity to run the equipment.
- Room thermometer to be fixed in the cabin
- Fire extinguisher to be provided.
- Provision for fixing sphygmomanometer 15cm dials type.
- Provision for Emergency medical kit or drug kit.
- Modern and plush interiors with neat and excellent finish.
- The statutory items / fixtures for vehicle should be fixed i.e. emergency lights, back lights, warning lights, front light bar and siren etc.
- Suction apparatus is to be provided and fixed in the patient cabin.
- Intubation Kit is also to be provided for airway management.
- Sufficient AC i.e of 1.5 Ton capacity AC is to be fitted in AC Ambulance.
- To keep sufficient fuel in the tank of the Ambulance to complete the trip.
- Provision of GPS system to monitor through our VTS System to know the movement & proper usage of Ambulance.
- To display the driving license of the concerned driver in the Ambulance, driver should wear ID card issued by concerned authorities and also the driver shall wear shoes and uniform.
- The Area GM / GM(E&M) Transport has right to refuse the person responsible for contravention if any to enter in to the premises of the company's establishments till the cause of such contravention is removed or informed in writing of the corrective action taken by contractor with and assurance about non-recurrence of such contravention.

Common specifications for the above vehicle:

All the vehicles should incorporate the required features, as specified vide DGMS Circular No. DGMS (Tech) Circular No.06 of 2020 dt. 27.02.2020

The important features for LMVs are as follows:

- a) Seat belt and seat belt reminder
- b) Auto dipping system for head lights

2) Eligibility criteria.

Preference for awarding the contract will be given in the following order.

- a) **1st Category:** Project affected persons means Project displaced persons and Land oustees come under 1st category and they will be treated equally.
Note: If 1st category persons are not available then 2nd category persons will be given opportunity. PAPs/PDPs/ Land oustees should not be in Government employment. Allotment of vehicle to PAP/ PDP including his/ her sons, should be restricted to one vehicle at a time.
- b) **2nd Category:** Dependents of Ex-Employees of SCCL who are not provided job or Ex-Employees of SCCL come under 2nd category.
Note: If 2nd category persons are not available then 3rd category persons will be given opportunity.
- c) **3rd Category:** Others come under 3rd category Persons falling under category 1 & 2 are permitted to deploy **one vehicle per head only**. Further, it is to inform that first preference will be given to MNG Area persons only. If no response is received within the

Area, then the offers of the other Areas will be considered in the same order of eligibility criteria.

Project displaced persons and land oustees, ex-employees/dependents of ex-employees who have been allotted/already selected for deployment of vehicle at any Area of SCCL under unit rate system are not eligible for this Enquiry and the same is to be confirmed by the Applicants.

After completion of the tender process and placement of order, if it is found that the person is already allotted / selected for deployment of vehicle at any other Area of SCCL, the vehicle will be withdrawn immediately and EMD and Security Deposit and pending bills, if any, will be Forfeited.

- d) If the Tenderer is a Project affected person / Project displaced person, his tender should accompany the following:

Letter duly signed by the Tenderer with the following details.

- i) Extent of land acquired.
- ii) Survey No.
- iii) Village.
- iv) Mandal.
- v) Award NO & date.
- vi) Purpose for which it was acquired.
- vii) Certificate from the Govt. Authorities about his identity.
- viii) Copies of PAN and Adhar Card

Therefore, the eligibility of Tenderer under the above Category is subject to verification of the genuineness of the details submitted by the Tenderer.

- e) In case of Dependents of Ex-employees of SCCL, who were not provided job or Ex-employees of SCCL, they should submit any of the following documents to the respective Personnel Department of SCCL of that Area.

SCCL Identity card / Hospital Book/SCCL pay slip with Employee code No. After submitting any of the above, they should get Certificate that he is dependent of Ex-employee of SCCL or Ex-employee of SCCL from that Area and submit the same to In-charge, personnel Dept., MNG Area, further, the In-charge, Personnel Department, MNG Area will forward the same to be enclosed to the application after due certification.

Without the above documents, the applications received cannot be considered for preference category.

- f) In case the tenderer is Driver-cum-owner, he is required to submit the relevant documents (valid driving license etc.).

- g) Lottery system will be conducted among all the received bids by:

Lottery shall be conducted in Unit rate Vehicles enquiries among all, the received bids by intimating the convenient date of draw to the firms who have submitted the bids for the enquiry. The date of draw shall be intimated by displaying on Notice Boards in all Areas and corporate.

- h) Draw will be conducted for number of firms equal to the number of vehicles and the firms will be selected. Additionally a number of firms equal to twice the number of vehicles will also be selected in the lottery and will be kept as standby.
- i) All the above firms which are selected in the lottery along with standby firms selected in lottery will be given lottery serial number and sent for technical evaluation.

- j) On confirming the technically and commercially acceptability the firms which are standing in lottery serial will be considered for the award of contract. Firms in the standby list will be considered for award of contract as per serial number in the lottery list on confirming their technically and commercially acceptability if any dropouts before their serial number. The standby list will be maintained for a period of 2(Two) years from the date of opening of concerned enquiry for future requirements of vehicles, if any

3) Tender Evaluation process:

Successful Tenderer shall be decided through draw of lots among the applicants who wish to carry out the work as per the priorities given at eligibility criteria:

NOTE: Offers received from prospective Tenderers of Manuguru Area who fall under 1st & 2nd Category will be given first preference for choosing Successful Tenderer. If no response is received from MNG Area, the offers of other Areas of SCCL will be taken into consideration.

The SCCL reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.
