- 1. Applications are invited from interested vehicle owners/contractors to deploy the subject vehicles along with driver on hire basis for use at Bhupalpalli Area, The Singareni Collieries Company Limited situated in Jayashankar Bhupalpalli district.
- 2. Tender documents will be issued to the eligible candidates after verification of applications.
- 3. EARNES MONEY DEPOSIT: EMD for Ambulance, 2WD Jeep, 4WD Jeep, 4WD Pick up van and 3T PF Truck.
 - a. <u>For Ambulance EMD Rs. 22,500/-</u> (Rupees Twenty two thousand five hundred only) shall be submitted along with tender and the successful tenderer shall deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) towards <u>Security Deposit</u> (either by cash or by DD) within two weeks from the date of commencement of work.
 - b. For 2WD Jeep, 4WD Jeep and 4WD Pick up van EMD Rs. 7,500/- Rupees seven thousand five hundred only) shall be submitted along with Tender and the successful tenderer shall deposit a sum of Rs. 5,000/- Rupees Five thousand only) towards Security Deposit (either by cash or by DD) within two weeks from the date of commencement of work.

- c. For 3T PF Truck: The tenderer has to deposit Rs. 10,000.00 per vehicle (Rupees Ten Thousand only towards Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) by cash in the office of DGM (F&A), BHP Area or Demand Draft payable at State Bank of Hyderabad, in favor of Singareni Collieries Co. Ltd. payable at Bhupalpalli only. DD payable on out station banks will not be accepted EMD in the form of cheques, fixed deposits and Bank Guarantees etc will not be accepted. Tender without EMD will not be considered and their offers stand disqualified. No interest will be paid by SCCL for EMD amount.
- 4. **SECURITY DEPOSIT:** The successful tenderer shall deposit sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) for 4WD Non AC Camper/1.0T or above capacity pickup van and Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) for 2WD fully equipped AC Ambulance as further security deposit (either by cash or by DD) within two weeks from the date of commencement of work and refunded after completion of contract.

NOTE: PROJECT AFFECTED PERSONS/DEPENDANTS OF EX-EMPLOYEES OF SCCL WHO WERE NOT PROVIDED WITH JOB; EX-EMPLOYEES OF SCCL ARE EXEMPTED FROM PAYMENT OF EMD AMOUNT.

B. Requirements (Compulsory):

- The Ambulance should be of standard design and should have minimum two stretcher holders cum flat seats both sides with suitable thickness and flat foam cushion seats to avoid discomfort to the patient, one scoop stretcher, two attendants seats in patients cabin, one doctors seat in drivers cabin, stand for 2 saline bottles, hangers for I.V. Fluids preferably with bottle immobilizer, First Aid Box, Drug Cabinet, Water Tank and wash Basin etc.
- > Provision of sliding windows should be provided in case of A/C System failure (for AC Ambulance).
- > A/C vent should be Roof mounted (for AC Ambulance).
- > Vinyl flooring which should be easily washable and for the purpose of disinfecting the Ambulance after shifting of the patient.
- > Seat Belts/Restraints both for patients and the attendant seat should be provided.
- Monococque type body (08 type model)
- > Two fans to be provided in the cabin.
- Multiple handle bars to be fixed.
- > Multiple LED Light points to be provided.
- > Wall clock to be fixed in the cabin.
- Provision for mobile charger to be fixed.
- > Two way communication with cabin/driver.
- O2 cylinder to fix with sufficient clamps to avoid movement and sound during running.
- > Required electric power supply for operating all the equipment (battery inventor, etc.)
- > Aluminum/Hindalium pulls out stretchers.
- > Extra battery/large capacity to run the equipment.
- > Room thermometer to be fixed in the cabin.
- > Fire extinguisher to be provided.
- > Provision for fixing sphygmomanometer 15cm dials type.
- > Provision for Emergency medical kit or drug kit.
- > Modern and plush interiors with neat and excellent finish.
- > The statutory items/fixtures for vehicle should be fixed i.e. emergency lights, back lights, warning lights, front light bar and siren etc.
- > Both side rearview mirrors
- > Reverse camera with monitor in the cabin
- Providing VTS system
- > Must be provided with main beacon emergency light system at top of the ambulance.
- > Backup horns/beacon devices must be provided to work when main beacon emergency light fails.
- > To keep sufficient fuel in the tank of the Ambulance to complete the trip.

- > To display the driving License of the concerned driver in the Ambulance, driver should wear ID card issued by concerned authorities and also the driver shall wear shoes and uniform.
- The Area GM/GM (E&M) Transport has right to refuse the person responsible for contravention if any to enter in to the premises of the company's establishments till the cause of such contravention is removed or informed in writing of the corrective action taken by contractor with an assurance about non-recurrence of such contravention.

7. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PREFERENCE CATEGORY:

- 1. Preference for awarding the contract will be given in the following order:
 - a. Project Affected Family / Project Displaced Family come under 1st category and they are to be treated equally.
 - **NOTE**: If the requirement of vehicle is not met with the above category then 2nd category persons will be given opportunity.
 - **b.** Dependents of Ex-employees of SCCL who were not provided with job (or) Ex-employees of SCCL come under 2nd category.
 - **NOTE**: If the requirement of vehicle is not met with the above Category then 3rd category persons will be given opportunity.
 - c. Others come under 3rd category.
- II. Priority will be given to 1st category persons, if not available 2nd category persons likewise.
- III. Persons fall under category 1, 2 & 3 are permitted to deploy only one vehicle at any given point of time at any place in SCCL.
- IV. If the requirement of vehicles is not met with the above 1 & 2 categories then others will be given opportunity.
- V. In case of Project Affected Persons/Project Displaced Persons / Ex-employees or Dependent of Ex-employees of SCCL, the vehicle should be in the name of tenderer only.
- VI. Dismissed employees of SCCL, shall not be considered as Ex-Employees of SCCL.
- VII. If, spouse/dependent of Ex-employee employed in place, shall not be considered.
- VIII. Vehicle withdrawn against any order in the SCCL will not be considered for deployment.
- IX. The tenderer should give acceptance for the vehicles they can deploy and SD shall be paid if the vehicle is allotted.
- X. In case tender are Project Affected Persons / Project Displaced Persons they should submit connected documents to Area Estate Officer, Bhupalpalli Area and should get certification to enclose to the application.
- XI. In case of tenderer is dependent of Ex-employee of SCCL or Ex-employee of SCCL, they should get certification from PM (Per), BHP and same is to be enclosed to the application.
- XII. Without certification as above at point No. (X) & (XI), application received cannot be considered for preference category.
- XIII. Project Affected Persons / Project Displaced Persons / Ex-employees or Dependent of Exemployees of SCCL / Others who are already selected for deployment of vehicles or already deployed vehicles at any Area of SCCL under unit rate system are not eligible for this enquiry, the same is to be confirm by the applicants in application form.
- XIV. Successful tenderer will be decided through draw of lottery among the applicants who wish to carry out the work as per the priorities given above.
- XV. If anything not clearly mentioned on application format by the applicant, in such cases decision of SCCL is final.
- XVI. The tenderer wish to provide brand new vehicle, he/she shall deploy the vehicle within 60 days along with driver(s) from the date of receipt of LOI or purchase order. However, the tenderer will be permitted to commence the work with a vehicle of not more than 2 years old and shall replace the same within 60 days from the date of receipt of order. In case the tenderer fails to replace within specified period. The contract will be terminated and EMD & Security Deposit shall be forfeited.

- XVII. The tenderer should quote for latest model, first time registered vehicle on his name and not earlier than the date of opening of the enquiry. Vehicles with permanent registration & valid fitness issued by Transport Authorities are only permitted for deployment and vehicles with temporary registration will not be accepted. The vehicle documents must be available with the driver at all times.
- XVIII. Vehicle drivers must have the thorough knowledge of the routes according to their allotted work.
- XIX. One tender form will be issued to one eligible candidate only by verifying their application form. One passport size photo must be attached by the applicant in the application of the tender document.
- XX. As per circular no. CRP/EST/land loser/misc/952, Dtd: 02.08.2010, the Area estates officer shall verify the documents as per NIT eligibility criteria.
- XXI. The applicant must submit the documents to establish the relationship with the land looser.
- XXII. The 3rd category tenderers should give acceptance for number of vehicles they can deploy. The EMD should be paid for the vehicles quoted.
- XXIII. If the tenderer is Project Affected Person / Project Displaced Person, his tender should accompany the following:

A letter duly signed by the tenderer with the following details:

- > Extent of land acquired.
- > Survey No.
- ➤ Village
- > Mandal
- > Award No. & Date
- > Purpose for which it was acquired.
- > Certificate from the concerned Government authorities about his identity.

Application form must be submitted by applicant to competent authorities (Area General Manager) must have the data of the above points.

On verification of above documents and certification from Area Estate Officer only, the offer will be considered for subject tender.

- XXIV. If already vehicle deployed on the name of awardees or their Legal Heirs / Ex- employees / Dependents of Ex-employees / Land Looser / Project Affected Person (PAF) / Project Displaced Person (PDF) under unit rate system at any Area of SCCL may not be considered again during the same period even though land or houses acquired in different awards.
- **XXV.** If technically acceptable offers are received for more than the required number of vehicles, then successful tenderers will be selected through suitable lottery system.
- XXVII. If the documents submitted by the tenderer are found to be incorrect at any stage of the tender, the offer will be rejected.
- XXVI. In case of dependants of ex-employees Of SCCL who were not provided job (OR) exemployees of SCCL they should submit any of the following documents to respective Personnel Dept. of SCCL of that Area.

SCCL identity card / Hospital Book / SCCL Pay slip with employee code number.

XXVII. After submitting any of the above, they should get certificate that he is dependant of exemployee of SCCL or ex-employee of SCCL from that area and submit the same to In-charge, Personnel Department, Bhupalpalli Area. Further, the in-charge, Personnel department, Bhupalpalli Area will forward the same to be enclosed to the application after due certification.

- XXVIII. In case the tenderer is driver-cum-owner, he is requested to submit the relevant documents like valid driving license etc.
 - XXIX. Project Affected Persons / Project Displaced Persons / Dependants of Ex-employees of SCCL (OR) Ex-employees of SCCL / Others are permitted to deploy only one vehicle per head.
 - XXX. In case, the number of eligible offers received is more than the required number of vehicles, the successful tenderer will be decided through draw of lots in the same order of eligibility criteria. The date of draw shall be intimated by displaying on notice boards.
- 8. Starting date of receipt of application forms: 03.09.2025
- 9. Closing date of receipt of application forms: 24.09.2025 up to 4.00 PM
- 10. Issue of tender documents: will be intimated later
- 11. Tenders submitted without the following will not be considered.
 - a) Requisite EMD.
 - b) Under preference category, if tenders submitted without RELEVANT CERTIFICATE from the concerned authorities as mentioned above.
- 12. Draw will be conducted for number of firms equal to the number of vehicles and the firms will be selected. Additionally a number of firms equal to twice the number of vehicles will also be selected in the lottery and will be kept as standby.
- 13. All the above firms which are selected in the lottery along with standby firms selected in lottery will be given lottery serial number and sent for technical evaluation.
- 14. On confirming the technically and commercially acceptability the firms which are standing in lottery serial will be considered for the award of contract. Firms in the standby list will be considered for award of contract as per serial number in the lottery list on confirming their technically and commercially acceptability if any dropouts before their serial number. The standby list will be maintained for a period of 2 (TWO) years from the date of opening of concerned enquiry for future requirements of vehicles, if any.
- 15. Tenders should be posted in a sealed envelope clearly super-scribed with Enquiry Number, date, name of the person, Father's name, address, phone numbers who is submitting the tender. Without the above & unsigned quotations will not be considered.
- 16. The successful tenderers under preference category should produce certificates IN ORIGINAL WITH PHOTO IDENTITY BEFORE RELEASE OF ORDERS.
- 17. Sometimes issue of corrigendum may be necessary to clarify doubts corrigendum shall e displayed in company's web site www.scclmines.com/Tenders/Area Purchase tenders only. The tenderers are therefore advised to visit the said website from time to time to keep them up dated.
