**UNIT RATE TENDER NOTICE**

The contractors who got registered as per SCCL's Revised Registration system and having been **registered under Unit Rate System for Manuguru Area only** are eligible to participate in the lottery system for the following works as per their class of Registration.

1. Contractors, who have not given option and not got registered under area specific, may approach O/o. GM (Civil) in person with their original registration certificate and ID card and get registered to specific area of their option before making application for participation.
2. **"The subject work under Unit Rate tender system is being taken up through cyclic system" From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 as per circular no.CRP/CVL/SI107/484, Dt: 25.02.2022, Contractors registered under Unit Rate System for Manuguru Area and not awarded with any of the outsourced works in the ongoing cycle are only eligible for participation.**
3. **"Contractors, who are registered under new/revised registration system as per Civil Contract manual 2023, are only eligible to participate".**
4. The intending eligible participants are required to submit the EMD amount at the time of application form, Earnest money Deposit can be paid in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) duly endorsed in favour of SCCL payable at Manuguru from Nationalized Bank.
5. Earnest Money deposit can be paid in the form of Crossed Demand draft (FDR/DD/BG in favour of 'The Singareni Collieries Company Limited. In case Bank Guarantees, the instruments are to be drawn on any of the Scheduled Banks notified by RBI.
6. If the EMD is paid in the form of Crossed Demand draft, it should be drawn on any Nationalized Bank/Scheduled Bank and payable at Manuguru only. DD's payable on outstation banks will not be accepted.
7. The FDR so submitted should be valid for a minimum period of 120 Days from the date of draw of the tenders. The same shall be extended by the successful tenderer for the duration of the contract till Earnest Money is refunded.

8. Along with his / their application, Contractor(s) should submit **(a)** copy of Identity Card of registration in SCCL & **(b)** EMD amount in form of FDR/DD/BG..
9. The undersigned reserves the right cancel/withdraw whole or part of the above mentioned work without assigning reasons what so ever.
10. The eligible registered contractors intending to participate shall submit application in prescribed format, on or before **07.05.2025 by 12.00 Noon at Office of AGM (Civil) /MNG.**
11. The lottery will be conducted on **07.05.2025 at 4.00 PM** in the office of **SO to GM/MNG** in presence of tender committee members & the available eligible contractors who are present at that time.
12. The successful contractor shall start the work within **Two weeks from the date of award** positively, failing which they will not be considered for lottery of future works till the works earlier allotted are started and substantial progress is shown on the works.
13. The schedule of approximate quantities is available at **The Office of AGM (Civil)/MNG** for ready perusal.
14. The tenderer should have an independent PF Code Number allotted by Assistant /Regional PF Commissioner. It is mandatory for the Contractor to cover contract labour under provision of **CMPF/CMPS** Scheme.
15. *The successful bidder shall employ the local persons not less than 80% for unskilled category of work.*
16. *The successful bidder shall also give preference to local persons in skilled category and shall employ as many as possible.*
17. *Local persons means persons from PDFs, PAFs and persons belonging to local area where coal mining operations are being carried on or shall be carried on in future.*
18. *First preference for employment shall be given to Project Displaced Families (PDFs) & Project Affected Families (PAFs) and then to other local persons.*
19. OPD/ Indoor medical treatment will be offered to the out sourcing workmen in Company's Hospitals/dispensaries for free of cost (excluding spouse or any dependents) to the extent of availability of medicines, pathological examination and other surgical treatment and they will not be allowed to get treatment in other than Company's hospital/ dispensaries (no referral cases).
20. The liability for payment of compensation (as per Workmen Compensation Act) to the contract labour for personal injury caused by accident arising out of and in the course of employment will rest on SCCL. However, the contractor has to produce necessary documentary evidence of having engaged the injured workmen on the work and the cause of accident is not due to his negligence etc.
21. Contract labour engaged on the work have to attend Initial Medical Examination (IME) at Company's Area Hospital at free of cost to ascertain fitness.
22. Safety Gadgets, i.e., Helmets, Shoes etc., if required, will have to be arranged by contractor at his cost and reimbursement will be done as per Approved Data Rates of SCCL.
23. If any MVTC training is required as per statutory, the same will be given by SCCL and the agency has to arrange the workmen going to be deployed in Mines Area, Work-shop, CHP etc., as per respective module. The training will be imparted at free of cost and the wages of contract workmen during training period shall be to the account of agency on submission of proof.
24. Contractor shall process a licence as required under Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970 & Contract labour (Regulation & Abolition) Central Rules 1971 & Satisfy all provisions of the Act.

25. Minimum wages as declared by Govt. from time to time are to be paid to the contract workmen by the Contractor. Any enhancement in minimum wages by Government during the subsistence of the contract and its extended period will be reimbursed by the Company. The payment of minimum wages to workmen will have to be made through bank accounts. After releasing the first month's bill, the contractor has to remit the wages in to the respective bank accounts of all the labour engaged; by him on the work. For releasing payments of work done for the subsequent months, the contractor has to produce proof of having remitted the previous months wages into the respective bank accounts of labour engaged by him.
26. The successful tenderer shall submit self attested copy of his PAN card/GST Registration Certificate after award of work so as the same shall be annexed to the agreement.
