1. The tender shall be two parts namely Technical bid and Price bid. Technical bid shall contain documents support of EMD. In price bid, the bidders should quote their uniform percentage on estimated value of the work. **The bidders who qualify in the Technical Evaluation only will be considered for price bid evaluation**, on approval of competent authority.
2. Interested bidders should participate by uploading relevant documents in e-portal along with the EMD as mentioned shall be paid online or by Challan generation through any Nationalized bank in favour of The Singareni Collieries Company Limited, Ramagundam-III Area. The EMD submitted shall be valid for the entire period of the contract from the date of opening of the tender.
3. The tenderers are allowed to submit the bids from the date of publishing the tender notice till **03.00 PM on DT: 02.05.2026** The **Technical Bid (Part-I)** of the tender will be opened on the same day *i.e.* **02.05.2026**, on at **4.00 PM** and price bid will be opened on **DT: 04.05.2026 at 4.00 PM** in the Office of Jr. Forest Officer, RG-III Area.
4. The bidder shall upload all the required documents / certificates/ statements. The bidder is liable to be disqualified and blacklisted, if false information is furnished in the forms/ certificates/ statements submitted in proof of qualification requirements and misled the company.
 - a) Proof of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) paid while participating in the tender.
5. Technical bid will be opened on the due date. The price bid of only those tenderers, who are found qualified in technical bid will be opened after technical evaluation of the bids is completed. The date of opening of price bid mentioned is only indicative date. In case of any extension of last date for submission of bids / date of opening of technical bids, suitable corrigendum will be released in the e-procurement platform.
6. The Earnest Money Deposit will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderer immediately after finalization of the L₁ tenderer.




7. The Company reserves the right to cancel/ withdraw whole or part of the above mentioned works without assigning any reason what so ever.
8. The Company employees should not participate in tenders either directly or indirectly.
9. Before quoting the rates, the bidders are advised to go through the NIT, Terms & Conditions, Estimate thoroughly. Bidders shall quote their rate in the online format and shall not quote less than minus 10% on the estimated contract value.
10. In case, more than one lowest tenderer quote the similar discount rate up to 10%, the work will be awarded by drawing the lottery among such tenderers (Maximum allowed discount rate 10%).
11. The successful agency shall be finalized by drawing a lottery among eligible bidders before the tender committee.
12. Though registration certificate is shown as mandatory in documents required screen. The same is not applicable for this work.
13. Though possessing of turnover, liquid assets/ Credit facilities is shown in the as mandatory in eligibility criteria screen. The same is not applicable for this work.
14. In the PQ stage, the following parameters also not applicable for this work
 - a. Key critical equipment
 - b. Previously executed works
 - c. Work done as a prime contractor
 - d. Key personnel
 - e. Works on hand / Tendered details
 - f. Eligibility criteria.

16. The Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
17. The intending tenderers are advised to inspect the areas personally before participating in the tenders.
18. As per the ltr No:CRP/FTY/A/2026/217 Dt: 27.02.2026, the MSME registered agency/contractor exempted from the payment of initial EMD and happened to be the successful bidder has to submit total EMD at the time of executing the Agreement, which will be converted into Security deposit. The Additional Security deposit applicable for discounted tenders as per the Approved Forestry Manual Shall also be collected from the successful bidder before entering into agreement.
19. Notwithstanding to anything stated above, The Singareni Collieries Company Limited reserves the right to assess the capability and capacity of intending tenderers to perform the contract.

Special conditions:

1. Before quoting the rate the agency shall inspect the site of proposed work.
2. No alteration shall be made in the tender schedule.

3. The quantities given in the tender schedule are tentative and they may increase (or) decrease in view of field conditions.
4. The quoted rates will remain firm till the completion of contract/during the period of contract.
5. Scope of the work includes felling of 100 selected Eucalyptus trees and conversion of Eucalyptus trees into chock timber of 1.22m long of > 55cm girth billets with saw and props of 3.5m length, Midgirth of 45 cm and thinner end girth of 36 cm and props should be straight. Conversion of Pulpwood into billets of 10-36 cm girth of varied length.
6. While disposing of the felled material such as timber, props and pulpwood, both empty and loaded vehicles shall be weighed at SCCL company weighbridges. The felled material (timber, props and pulpwood) shall then be transported, after weighment to RG-II Stores with a proper challan within 24 hours of felling. Failing this, the felled material will be transported by alternate means under the supervision of the Forestry Department and any additional cost incurred shall be recovered from the agency's pending bills, in addition to the imposing of penalties as per the terms and conditions of the contract.
7. The work should be executed within 15days from the date of commencement.
8. No trees/timber etc. other than those shown by the Area Forest Officer or his representative shall be felled/lifted.
9. All the felled material should be cut into required sizes with saw only.
10. No timber/props/pulpwood should be carried outside from the felling area without proper documents issued by the Company.
11. The contractor should bring his own tools and implements.
12. All the felled material should be protected by the contractor. The contractor should bound to complete the work in the shown plantation areas of RG-III area within the tender period and also as per the instructions given by the Incharge Officer from time to time.
13. The agency should make all necessary arrangements for complete protection of felled material in the site till the completion of the works in all respects, failing which the penalties should be imposed on the agency if any.
14. The General terms and conditions furnished in the tender will also be applicable wherever it is deemed fit for also for transportation/disposal of pulpwood works.
