-	ACCUPATION OF THE PROPERTY OF	b) Rs.30,000/- Beyond 30,000 Tonnes Per Annum

The prescribed application fee should be made in Demand Draft in favour of GOAL INDIA LIMITED; 40, NETAJI SUBASH ROAD, KOLKATA. The application fee/processing fee once remitted and deposited, is NON-REFUNDABLE whether the application/request is ACCEPTED OR REJECTED by the competent authority for grant of long term coal linkage.
